Executive Summary:

The Heugh Battery Museum based in Hartlepool has applied for funding from the PCC for a CCTV System to give extra protection to the museum site.

Additional security is considered by the applicants to be appropriate in view of the nature of the site (a former Ministry of Defence installation) and the content of their exhibitions, which focus upon weaponry and defence in the context of the North East Bombardment.

This application supports the PCC's preventative priority of diverting people from offending.
