REQUEST: For PCC approval following agreement at the funding meeting on 18 November 2015

Title: Lynnfield Primary - CCTV

Executive Summary:

The school has a Multi-Use Games Area (MUGA) that the community can visit once the school has finished or on a weekend. The school has previously had CCTV which has been dismantled and since then there has been an increase in anti-social behaviour around the school area. The school would like to install CCTV again to help reduce anti-social behaviour in the area. Lynnfield Primary had applied for £7,000 and the PCC agreed to £1,000 contribution subject to the school being successful in securing the balance of the funding from other sources.

This application supports the PCC's preventative priority of diverting people from offending.

Decision: To approve £1,000 spend from the PCC Community Safety Initiative Fund to Lynnfield Primary School for CCTV installation.




