REQUEST: For PCC approval following agreement at the funding meeting on 18 November 2015

Title: MaSters Training Centre

Executive Summary:

MaSters Training Centre in Thornaby, Stockton on Tees aim to help and support the community in the surrounding areas. Their aim is to help engage young people in activities and outdoor pursuits and particularly work with young people who have been in trouble and may be at risk of offending.

The Centre have applied to the PCC Community Safety Initiative Fund to purchase arts and crafts material, sports equipment and the hire of a sports hall for a project they are running. All youngsters who engage with the project will be working toward a NCFE Qualification, their V Certs are equivalent to BTEC and higher grade GCSE.

This application supports the PCC's priority of diverting people from offending, with a focus on rehabilitation and the prevention of reoffending.

Decision: To approve £1,120 spend from the PCC Community Safety Initiative Fund to MaSters Training Centre for equipment and hire of a sports hall.




