Title: Streets Ahead for Information - Crime prevention equipment

Executive Summary:

This project will focus on the Newport ward in Middlesbrough within this area house burglaries are the biggest problem, with 16 occurring in May 2015.

Relevant crime prevention items will be purchased that can be easily fitted by residents, for officers to hand out when they are visiting residents homes offering advice and guidance on burglaries. The items will be targeted towards victims of burglary and also those that are vulnerable due to their age, disability, disrepair at the property or other vulnerability.

This initiative supports both the PCC's priority of ensuring a better deal for victims and witnesses and his preventative priority of diverting people from offending, with a focus on rehabilitation and the prevention of Re-offending

Decision: To approve £2500 spend from the PCC Community Safety Initiative Fund to Streets Ahead for Information, in order to purchase crime prevention equipment.
