Executive Summary:

Justice First applied for funding from the PCCs Community Safety Initiatives fund to provide a one day, multi-cultural football tournament during refugee week in June 2015. The significant and underpinning aim of the event is to build positive relationships in the wider community, promote community cohesion, reduce fear of crime/fear of authorities, and enhance social integration between various social and cultural groups living in Cleveland.

The tournament is expected to have 24 teams of eight players, a total of 192 players and beneficiaries directly at the event, as well as being attended by the police, Red Cross and MIND. Anticipated benefits will be increased engagement with ethnic minority groups, helping to reduce the fear of crime through positive interaction, enhancing community cohesion through healthy activities and enhancing confidence by being valued.

To approve £900 funding contribution towards a multi-cultural football tournament.


