Executive Summary:

MaSters Training Centre, based in Stockton, helps young people with Stockton and Middlesbrough develop their skills to help them progress into employment or/and further education and independent living.

The Centre has been accepted to deliver a course known as PSHE (personal, social and health education). The course which will be called the SOOTY Project (Staying out of Trouble Young) will be aimed at young people who have little or no knowledge of the modules and also offenders or youngsters at risk of offending. SOOTY will cover topics such as; keeping healthy, social relationships, careers, intimate relationships and economic responsibly.

The SOOTY Project supports the PCCs priorities of tackling re-offending, working together to make Cleveland safer and securing the future of our communities.




