Executive Summary:

Stockton Crime Prevention Panel have set up a scheme called The Safe At Home Scheme which makes way for qualified crime prevention officers to visit victims and put security measures in place to make people's homes more secure. In return this allows victims to remain and feel safe within their own home.

The Panel have applied for funding to purchase equipment such as security lighting, security hardware and CCTV devices. They also want to improve door security on highlighted vulnerable properties to prevent them from becoming repeat victims.


