Title:

Charltons Community Centre

Executive Summary:

Charltons Community Centre is a voluntary ran charity, providing community facilities for the village of Charltons and its surrounding towns and villages. The committee endeavour to keep the facility operational for the use of the residents and local groups to encourage social cohesion and wellbeing.

The Centre has applied for funding from the Police Property Act Fund to help with part of the ongoing renovation plans for the centre. The centre was developed to allow disabled access, although the centre has an existing ramp and railings, the railings need some attention and maintenance. It is the aim of this project to hold a series of workshops with a local blacksmith, for the children and young people who live in the surrounding area of the centre to attend. It is hoped that from the workshops a design will be developed for a set of new railings, incorporating the area's mining heritage and the natural landscape.

Decision:

To approve £1582.80 spend from the Police Property Act Fund to Charltons Community Centre for workshops to improve ramp and railings for disabled access to the centre.
