Title: Funding for Biker Boyz

Executive Summary: Hartlepool Borough Council is running a diversionary bike repair project for young people called 'Biker Boyz'. The members of the project have either breached their antisocial behaviour (ASB) agreements or are involved in ASB. The project aims to divert the young people from reoffending. A Restorative Justice Coordinator will be working closely with the members and providing support where necessary.

The funding provided will be used to purchase the necessary tools and equipment needed to sustain the bike repair project and for an ASDAN accreditation for the young people involved.

This project supports the PCC's objective of Tackling Re-offending.

Decision: To approve £1,000 from the Community Safety Initiative Fund towards the Biker Boyz project based in Hartlepool.


