Title: Funding - Street Angels 2017			
<p>Executive Summary: The Cleveland Street Angels Coordinators Group is a collaboration of all 5 Street Angels projects operating in the Cleveland area (Boro Angels, Hartlepool Town Pastors, Guisborough Nightlight, Stockton Town Pastors, Redcar Beacons). Each of the projects are independent but affiliated to the national Christian Nightlife Initiatives (CNI) charity, and the group is administrated under its guidance. The projects provide a caring presence in Town Centres on Friday &/or Saturday nights during the 'night time economy' period when members of the public may become vulnerable and in need of help.</p> <p>Cleveland Street Angels have applied for funding for a £2,000 contribution towards their Regional Street Angels Conference on 29th June 2017 to which 15 regional projects are attending. They have also requested £3,000 to contribute towards the continued running costs of each of the 5 local projects. The running costs include insurances, premises rent, volunteer training, clothing and equipment and supplies such as first aid, bottled water and flipflops.</p>
