Executive Summary: I have today (4 July 2018) submitted a Memorandum to the Independent Office for Police Conduct (the IOPC) under Paragraph 23(7) of Schedule 3 to the Police Reform Act 2002.

The Memorandum sets out my intended course of action following a report from the IOPC in respect of a complaint against an officer of the rank of Chief Constable.

The legal process does not permit me to publish any further details at this stage. I intend to publish full details of the case as soon as the process permits me to do so and to the maximum extent permitted by law.




