Executive Summary: Easterside Partnership was set up in 1998 with the aim of promoting a safe community to live in and bringing residents together. The Partnership have requested funding from the PCC to contribute to a planned day trip to Flamingo Land for disadvantaged families from the area over the school summer holidays. This supports the PCC's commitment to investing in local community groups to help them build safer neighbourhoods. The funding requested covers the coach hire from Easterside to Flamingo Land return and also a contribution towards ticket purchase for 20 adults and 38 children. This initiative supports the PCC's objective of Securing the Future of Our Communities.
