*Please could you provide us with a list of all female victims of homicide which your authority has been responsible for investigating for the years 2009 – 2013 inclusive and, for each victim, any other details that you may hold about the victim, the accused and the circumstances of this homicide (in particular in relation to the age of the victim, the sex of the accused and the relationship between the accused and the victim). Please include names of the victims and the accused.*

This request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Regarding your request I can now inform you that I have completed my enquiries and that my reply on behalf of the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Cleveland is as follows.
