a. Has the service purchased any "Ice Cleats" in the last 3 years? An "Ice cleat" is a footwear accessory that is attached to shoes or boots to give added grip to prevent trips on snow or ice. A picture is attached showing an Ice Cleat.

b. If the answer is "Yes" for question 1, how many Ice Cleats did the service buy and who from?

2. Accidents

How many of your employees were injured last year due to slip, trips or falls outdoors in icy/snowy conditions?

3. Contact Names

Please can you confirm the name, job title and email address for the following:

a. Head of Health and Safety

b. Head of Procurement

c. Stores Manager (i.e. buying stock and warehousing it for use by Council employees in the future).

d. Chief Constable

Please respond by return e-mail if you have any queries. We look forward to hearing from you. Many thanks in advance for your assistance.
