I write following your FOI request dated 8th August 2014 in which you request;

Please can you provide files relating to disclosure of actual invoice expenditure in CSV or XLS format for the period April 2012 to November 2012. Ideally, I require information covering all levels of expenditure, however, information covering expenditure above £25,000 will suffice if necessary. Alternatively, if the Authority currently publishes the information via your website please can you provide the relevant web page link?

This request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Your request has been sent to and received by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Cleveland who took up office in November 2012, prior to that the scrutiny of Police Force's and Chief Constables was carried out by Police Authorities.

Regarding your request I can now inform you that I have completed my enquiries and that my reply on behalf of the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Cleveland is as follows.

I can confirm that the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Cleveland does hold this information from November 2012.
