



# Cleveland Police

For the 12 months ending October 2021

The **National Crime and Policing Measures** are designed to help us focus our efforts on key national priorities and help to demonstrate value for money in policing. Whilst some of these measures are serviced by police data, others rely on data held by other agencies which is not always accessible in a timely manner. Where this is the case, proxy measures (marked as \*) have been used in order to provide additional context and an indication of local delivery against the desired outcomes.

## Reduce murder and homicide



### How do we compare?

There have been 9 **homicides** in the 12 months to October 2021, this compares to 8 in the 12 months to October 2019.

## Disrupt drugs supply and county lines



### How do we compare?

There have been 2 **drug related homicides** in the 12 months to October 2021, this compares to 1 in the 12 months to October 2019.

### How do we compare?

There have been 728 **knife crimes\*** and 161 **gun crimes** in the 12 months to October 2021. This compares to 586<sup>1</sup> knife crimes and 71 gun crimes in the 12 months to October 2019.

### How do we compare?

There have been 6904 **neighbourhood crimes** in the 12 months to October 2021. This compares to 9097 in the 12 months to October 2019.

### How do we compare?

Satisfaction levels amongst victims of domestic abuse were 86% in the 12 months to October 2021. This compares to 84% in the 12 months to October 2021

### How do we compare?

There have been 5494 **cyber crimes\*** in the 12 months to October 2021, this compares to 2913 in the 12 months to October 2019.

1. In March 2021 Cleveland Police introduced a new piece of software aimed at improving the quality of our data relating to knife crime. As a result we are now able to identify a number of additional crimes which might previously have excluded from our knife crime statistics. Previous year comparisons therefore need to be treated with caution, particularly when an apparent increase is observed.
