Funding has been requested to purchase equipment and materials to run a weekly creative session for 15 weeks at Saltburn Woodland Centre. The sessions will support people who have been a victim of crime linking in with Victim Care and Advice Service. Individuals from hard to reach groups will also be invited along to the sessions. Whippet Up believe that engaging in creative activities has a positive impact on individuals wellbeing. This initiative supports the PCC's objective of a Better Deal for Victims and Witnesses.


