Practical Peers

Executive Summary:

Hardwick in Partnership Ltd would like to provide practical activity sessions, in small groups, for young people who have been identified as being at risk of participating in antisocial behaviour. The sessions would create a pathway that encourages the young person to participate and gain practical skills, producing an output that will give them a sense of achievement and pride in their work.

Key elements in the programme are of a practical nature to include mechanics, in a fully outfitted garage setting and joinery skills in our fully equipped joinery resource. The Partnership plan to provide 20 sessions with a fully qualified project worker that will encompass both a practical output and engender safe working practices that will add to the skills base of each participant. The Partnership requested funding for £3,000 for 20 sessions at a cost of £150 per session.

This project supports the PCCs priorities of tackling re-offending, working together to make Cleveland safer and securing the future of our communities.

Decision:

To approve £3,000 spend from the Community Safety Initiative Fund for 'Practical Peers' delivered by Hardwick in Partnership Limited.


