The DBS income regularly over achieves the budget requested in this bid. In 2015/16 DBS income over achieved by £53k against a £242k budget. The £14,000 would cover the costs of the Diclosure Team's overtime pressure. The current pressure has come about due to the volume of disclosures received, if there is a high volume overtime needs to be worked which drives up the costs. However, as the overtime is claimed for as part of the monthly return, the income received will increase to the amount of the overtime worked. Therefore any increase in costs will be covered by an increase in income. Without this bid for income, this would become a significant overspend against the Professional Standards budget.
