The Victim Care and Advice Service (VCAS) support victims of crime that are particularly vulnerable and need help to cope and recover, those that have been repeat victims and those that are intimidated.						
VCAS have requested funding to prepare a short film on Restorative Justice, which is the process which brings victims and offenders together to discuss their account of the same incident, with the aim of putting victims back in control and presenting offenders with the consequences of their actions. It particularly helps those that have been emotionally effected by the crime and have struggled to move on. The DVD will include interviews with three victims that have been through the Restorative Justice process that can be used to promote the intervention and to help to give victims the confidence take their interest further.  The funding provided supports the PCCs objectives of Investing in our Police, a Better Deal for Victims, Tackling Re-offending and Working Together to Make Cleveland Safer.
