#### REQUEST:

To approve spend from the PCC Community Safety Initiative Fund for the Hartlepool Unit of the Cleveland Police Cadets to purchase 100 padlock alarms to support Operation Scarecrow, a crime prevention/reduction initiative for allotments in the Hartlepool area.

#### Title:

Hartlepool Cadets Operation Scarecrow

### **Executive Summary:**

To approve £745 spend from the PCC Community Safety Initiatives fund to enable the Hartlepool Unit of the Cleveland Police Cadets to purchase 100 padlock alarms to support a crime prevention/reduction initiative for allotments in the Hartlepool area.

The initiative is a joint Operation between the Integrated Neighbourhood Teams (INTS) and the Hartlepool Police Cadets, named Operation Scarecrow, which is aimed at crime prevention and reduction for allotments in the Local Policing Area.

The Operation will take place in 3 phases carried out over 3 consecutive weeks. As part of Phase 1 the cadets will be taught how to deliver crime prevention advice. This training will be delivered by a Crime Prevention Officer from Hartlepool Borough Council. The cadets will also design a crime prevention leaflet. Phase 2 will involve the distribution of the leaflets and property marking at the allotments. The leaflets will include the date and time of Phase 3 which will involve the distribution of 100 padlock alarms together with pedal cycle labels which have been donated by Hartlepool Borough Council Crime Prevention.

### **Decision:**

To approve £745 spend from the PCC Community Safety Initiatives fund to enable the Hartlepool Unit of the Cleveland Police Cadets to purchase 100 padlock alarms to support a crime prevention/reduction initiative for allotments in the Hartlepool area.
