Title: Middlesbrough FC Kicks Funding			
Executive Summary: Kicks is a national initiative funded by the Premier League that uses football and the brand of a professional football club to engage 8 to 18 year olds in deprived areas where crime, antisocial behaviour and youth violence are prevalent. Premiership funding is dependent on match funding being available locally. MFC Foundation have requested funding to continue the delivery of the Kicks Programme in Middlesbrough, Stockton, Hartlepool and Redcar and Cleveland. Activity is targeted at areas where many of the young people who attend are at risk of offending, or are known offenders. The benefits of the deliverables hope to include a reduction in youth crime and antisocial behaviour in the targeted areas, and an increase in community cohesion. The Kicks Programme supports the PCC's objectives of Tackling Anti-Social Behaviour Head-on and Preventing, Reducing and Tackling Serious Violence
