The **National Crime and Policing Measures** are designed to help us focus our efforts on key national priorities and demonstrate value for money in policing. Whilst some of these measures are serviced by police data, others rely on data held by other agencies which is not always accessible in a timely manner. Where possible, the information provided here shows the current position, at the end of December 2025, compared to the baseline position in December 2019.

We have recorded 9 homicides in the 12 months to December 2025, this compares to 7 in the 12 months to December 2019.

### Neighbourhood crime\*

We have recorded 6966 neighbourhood crimes\* in the 12 months to December 2025. This compares to 8988 in the 12 months to December 2019.

## Improve victim satisfaction

Satisfaction amongst victims of domestic abuse

### Victim Satisfaction

Satisfaction levels amongst victims of domestic abuse were 79% in the 12 months to December 2025, this compares to 82% in the 12 months to December 2019.

Overall victim satisfaction with police

Satisfaction levels amongst all victims are 72% in the 12 months to December 2025. Due to changes in the way this information is collected, historical comparison to 2019 cannot be made.
